Transient Data

Review of student enrollment start status and date, active enrolment at end date, and total number of enrolled days at Newport.

Review of student school enrollment of time

Accountability Data

Transient students in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 11 who have been enrolled at Newport Independent for at least 100 days.

This includes students who are new to Newport this year and those who have already left us.

Missing Children

The Kentucky State Police provide an imported daily file to IC. An email notification is sent to the Principal of the child's school should they be enrolled in KY.

These notifications are included in the missing child user group.

Student transfers into Newport Independent YTD and continue to be enrolled at Newport Independent

188 student transfers into and out of Newport Independent YTD and are still enrolled in Newport

Who are we accountable for?

115 students that are new to Newport at some point in this school year (and did not start the first day) will be tested in an accountable grade with at least 100 days in district.

17 students who have left us this school year are accountable to Newport in a tested grade as of 04/01/22.

Missing Children

33 of our students have been reported missing to the Kentucky State Police this school year alone. Based on IC notification review only, we are believed to have more missing children per year than any other school district in KY. **A formal request is submitted to KDE for confirmation.**

This does not account for our students that are whereabouts unknown.

We continue to have 1 missing child and are thankful for the return of a student after 1 year of having no known whereabouts as an unaccompanied minor.
