

Due to an increase in referrals and eligibility placements that require special education services at Southside Elementary. Caseload for K-5th grade Learning and Behavior Disability (LBD) teachers is capped at 15 per KDE requirement; the staff will begin the 2022-23 school year over the legal caseload number.
