SUBJECT: Surplus Auction

<u>ISSUE:</u> I am requesting that the Board grant Joe Stuecker permission to hold a surplus property auction on Thursday, June 16, 2022, at 1 pm with a rain date of Friday, June 17, 2022, at 1 pm. The auction will be held behind the Hardin County School's Food Service Building at 2514 Leitchfield Road.

FACTS: We are required by Kentucky State Law to dispose of any surplus property by holding an auction for the general public. We have accumulated surplus property no longer needed in the schools, such as student desks, tables, chairs and other miscellaneous items. We intend to dispose of this property through a public auction.
