#### 4. Other Requests- Instructional Resources

ECHS would like to request that the interactive screens demonstrated by Virtual Technologies at a meeting with Mr. Simpson and district leadership be purchased for each of our classrooms. Technology for teachers has not been upgraded since the Smartboards were put into classrooms during the last renovation of the high school, approximately 15 years ago. Many of the existing Smart Boards no longer function correctly as the company does not provide updates for their product any longer, and projector bulbs burn out quickly and are expensive to replace. The interactive functions of the screen/computer demonstrated by Virtual Technologies has the ability to have interactive instruction going on in every classroom to better engage students and give teachers the tools they need to provide dynamic instruction in their classrooms for all students. These interactive boards also have a 10 year+ lifespan. Mr. Simpson said the cost would be roughly \$3000 per screen, but he is getting a quote for what it would cost for the school.

If it is not possible for each classroom to have them for next year, being able to purchase them for our core subjects (a total of 19) would be a tremendous help in upgrading the technology for our subjects that are assessed through the ACT and the KSA state testing.
