- Lincoln students in grades 2 – 6 have taken their Spring STAR tests in the subjects of Reading and Math. We look forward to sharing this student growth data with you at the May board of education meeting.
- During our recent academic conferences held on Wednesday, May 30th, we had 91% of our students represented for a one-on-one conference with their guardian and teacher.
- We had over fifty children signed up for preschool and kindergarten at our recent “*Come Grow with Us*” registration event held last week. It was the best turn-out that we have ever had at a registration event.
- Our School-wide Reading Program adoption is going quite well. The committee consists of a representative from each grade level and we have narrowed our selection to two choices. We should have our final decision by the end of this month. Our teaching staff is excited about this new program to implement with our students and we are very grateful to Mr. Brewer and the board of education.
- The LES SBDM and administration have been busy holding interviews for our open teaching positions for the 22-23 school year. At this date, we are fully staffed for this upcoming school year. We are thrilled to add these teachers to our staff.
