## HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Recognizing the exemplary work and dedication extended by all KCSD employees during the past two years and the current economic inflation rate, a majority of the 2023 Salary Schedule items have been increased by $5.0 \%$. KCSD appreciates the continued hard work by all employees and progress toward excellence in all operations throughout the district.

Salaries for certified personnel shall be based on a single salary schedule providing, at minimum, for the number of working days required by law. Management and KCEA have agreed to a specific pay increase for the 2023187 Day Certified Salary Schedule. The certified salary schedule increase from 2022 is $5.0 \%$. Experience increases will also be recognized per Board Policy.

The Classified Salary Schedules also reflect an increase of $5.0 \%$ and experience increases will be recognized per Board Policy. The pay schedules related to Supplemental roles and positions held in addition to an employee's primary position also reflect a $5.0 \%$ increase.
