

Dear Wes,

In the past, the Henderson County School Board has supported the 4-H Camping Program by providing the use of school buses to transport 4-Hers to camp. With this support from the school board, the 4-H camping program in Henderson County has been one of the strongest in the area and has continued to grow exponentially.

This year, Henderson County is scheduled to go to 4-H Camp on July 5-8, 2022. At this time, I am requesting buses to transport approximately 215 4-Hers and counselors to and from West Kentucky 4-H Camp in Dawson Springs. Henderson County is currently limited to 190 camper spots along with 30 counselors (teens and adults).

We would need the buses to transport the 4-Hers from either the Henderson County Extension Office or on Tuesday, July 5 to Dawson Springs and then return from Dawson Springs with the same group on Friday, July 8. Departure time will be around 9:00am on July 5 and return from camp about 2:30pm) on July 8.

In past years, busses were left at 4-H Camp and bus drivers were drove back to Henderson by a Henderson County Extension employee.
