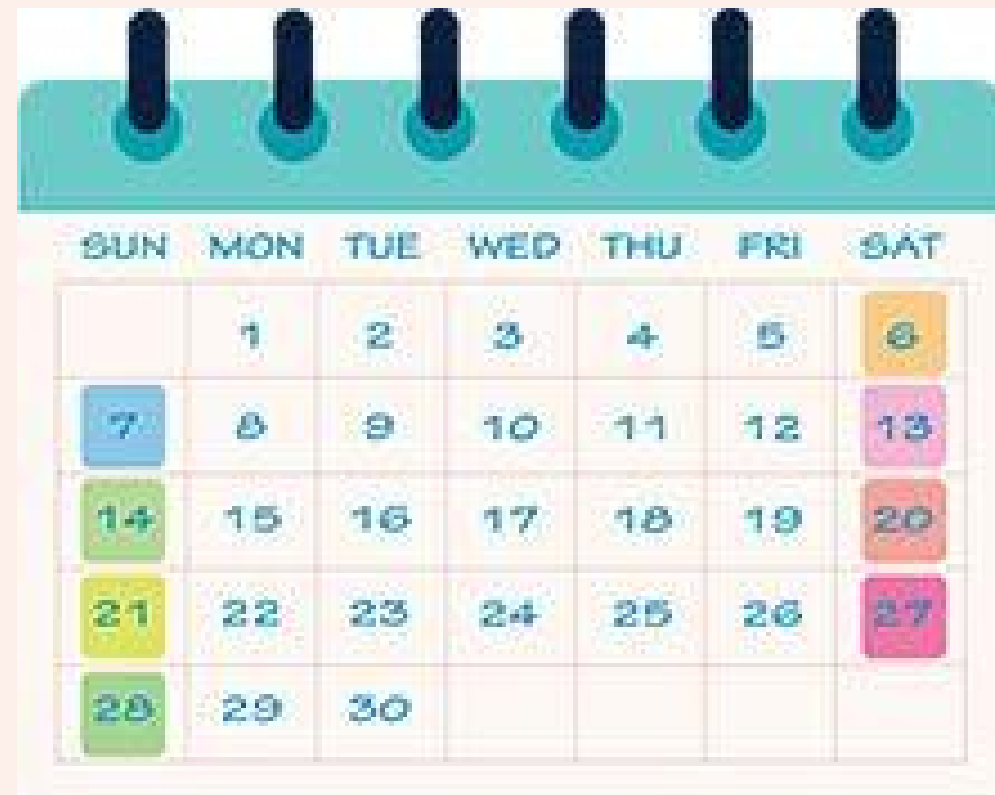


General Information

01

By May 20th

- Recruit certified and classified staff
- Identify students who will be participating
- Contact parents, etc. and secure dates/time attending

03

By May 27th

- Student names per school and week participating in summer learning that will need bus transportation here
- Provide summer learning plan/schedule to Usher

02

By May 20th

- Staff need to apply by this time
- Staff can work at other sites
- Subs can apply as needed for your site here (certified and classified)

04

By June 7th

- All supplies ordered and delivered for all 4 weeks of summer learning and delivered for June and July camps

-Summer Camp Learning 2022 will only occur in the morning. Breakfast and transportation will be provided to students at each school site, as needed.



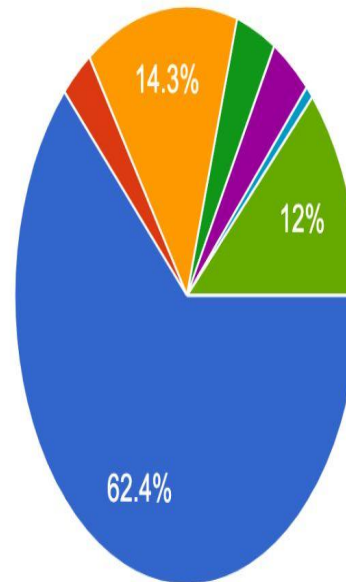
-

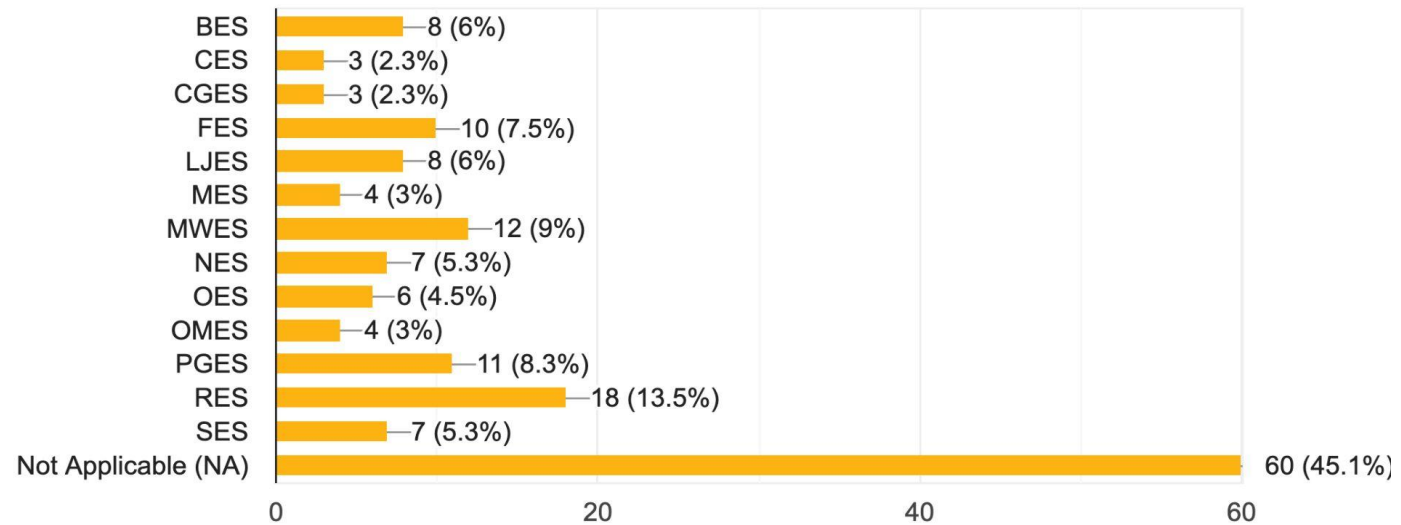

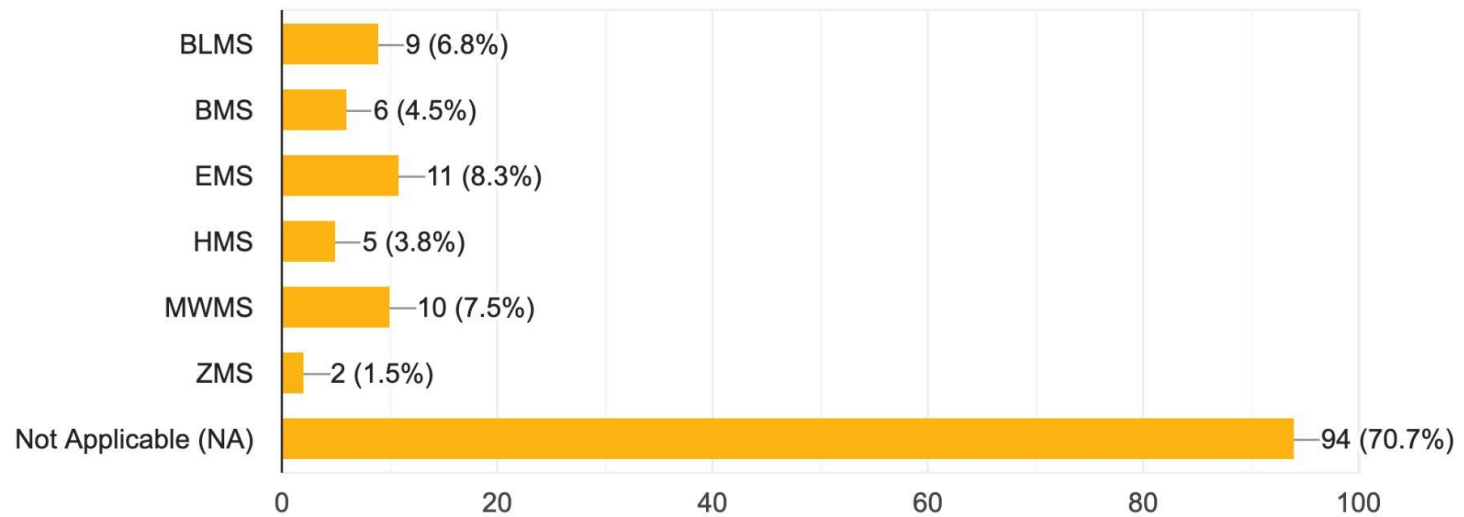

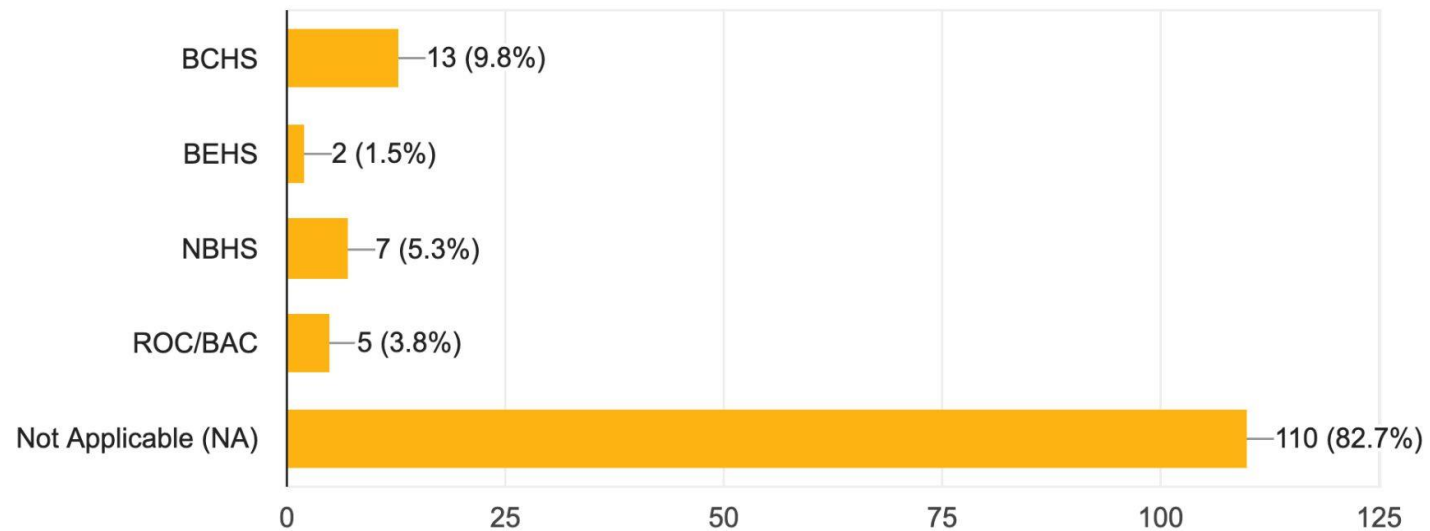
