Positive Developments and Highlights

The State Archery Championship returned to a single-site event in 2022 at Ephram White Gymnasium in Bowling Green, Ky. after conducting the event across four semi-state locations in 2021 in response to the pandemic.

Issues of Concern (legal, playing Rules, fiscal management, etc.)

The differences in KHSAA and NASP competition can be a source of confusion for coaches. An emphasis will be made to clarify KHSAA rules, particularly as it relates to team composition, prior to next season.

The lengthy window of permissible dates for regional tournaments causes scheduling issues with the various spring break schedules used by school districts.

Championship Update/Review

As the KHSAA does not own any targets, the Association is dependent upon the host and local member schools to supply targets and equipment for the event. Thankfully, Warren East HS has been a tremendous help in the execution of this event. With that said, there may be a low-cost solution to utilize targets provided by NASP in the future.

There was considerable debate at the event regarding the pros and cons of adult scoring versus student scoring, with groups arguing on both sides. Staff will determine the best course moving forward, while taking into consideration additional staffing needs (officials/scorers) and an adjusted time schedule. This is the first time a full-time NASP employee was not present at the state championship which left a void when it came to having a "head official" interpret NASP tournament rules and regulations.
