The bass fishing team had one boat (2 fishermen), Gavin Stevens and Quinn Harmon qualify for the state tournament. They will compete on May 13 and 14 at Kentucky Dam Marina.

The boys archery team advanced to the state tournament where they finished 12th in the state. Two girls qualified individually for the state tournament.

The district for baseball and softball will be at Webster County High School on May 16th and 17th. Both HCHS teams have a first round bye and will play in the championship game on May 17th.

The baseball team is currently 18-9. They started the year 3-7 and are 15-2 since. They will compete in the 2nd Region Tournament on May 22 in Hopkinsville.

The softball team is currently 25-1 with wins over top ranked teams including McCracken County and Madisonville North Hopkins. They will compete in the 2nd Region Tournament the week of May 23.

The track teams are having a great season. The girls team has finished in 1st place in the Spring Relays, Colonel Classic, Invitational of the South, Owensboro Invitational and the HIT. The regional meet is May 24 at Apollo High School. We are hoping for multiple individuals to qualify for state.

The tennis teams have doubled in size from last year. The girls are second in the region and the boys are much improved. Hopkinsville High School will host the regional tournament May 16-18.
