## SFCC – HB1 LAVEC Grant

Newport Independent Schools was awarded a grant to upgrade our Local Area Vocational Education Center in the amount of \$2,145,300, with the requirement we must match 10% of the award amount with state/local funds. We currently already have a board approved BG in place to renovate the Family Consumer Science (FCS) so that we can begin offering Culinary. For us to begin offering this pathway we must have these renovations in place to comply with KDE regulations to bring our current FCS kitchen up to code.

## **BG Scope of Work**

This project consists of complete renovation of the existing Graphic Arts, Art, and Mac Lab at the High School to create a space for the new Culinary pathway program. The Family and Consumer Science space will be moved from the upper level to the lower level to be adjacent to the new Culinary area. The existing Family and Consumer Science Area on the upper level will be converted into an Art Classroom. All spaces renovated will receive plan reconfiguration as required and all new fit and finishes.

We have the bonding capacity to do a bond sale for the remaining amount to avoid pulling from GF. However, I would recommend for consideration that the remaining funds be pulled from the Mildred Dean account as this would be investment for students and a perfect utilization of those funds.
