Retired long-term substitute teachers are paid based on their Daily Wage Threshold (DWT) once they complete twenty (20) consecutive days in the same position.

In the event a retired certified employee subs for an interim administrative position, they will be paid their DWT from day one regardless of duration.

A long-term substitute teacher will be paid on a regular teacher salary schedule, according to the substitute teacher's rank and experience retroactive to the first day of the consecutive assignment for each day worked during the consecutive assignment. A substitute must hold a current teaching certificate or Statement of Eligibility in order to receive teacher salary for a long-term assignment.
