History/Background: The FCHS Jaguar Track and Field Team, in its inaugural season, has captured the spirit of what it means to be a team of the community and school. Countless community members have volunteered time to help at track meets, local organizations have donated water snacks, and a multitude of school employees (including those from other district schools) have come out to express just how proud they are of our running Jags! As a team of 52 athletes--representing every club/team/organization from within the school--the FCHS Track Jags have raised money in their two short months of existence to pay for their uniforms and essential equipment that were needed to complete the season. At regional competition, the Track Jags brought about more school firsts, sending 17 individual athletes to State Competition, and finishing as Runner-Up in the girls' division and third place in the boys' division. The meet is in Lexington on June 3rd and we would like to be able to give our qualifying athletes a hero's honor. The plan is to transport the students to the meet, provide them an overnight accommodation, and have a team meal. Under a normal year's circumstances the team could easily fund such a trip. However, due to the expenses of being a start-up program, we are requesting your consideration for helping with the funding for this occasion.
