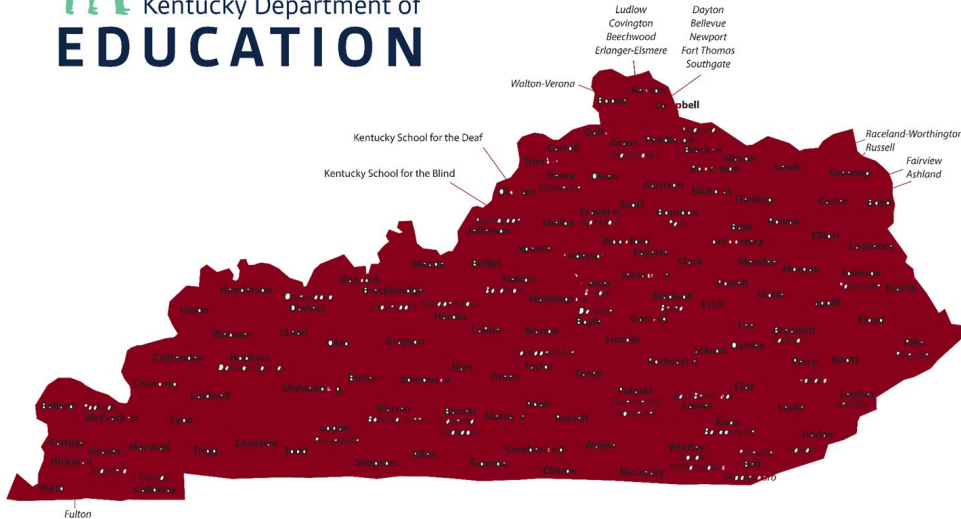

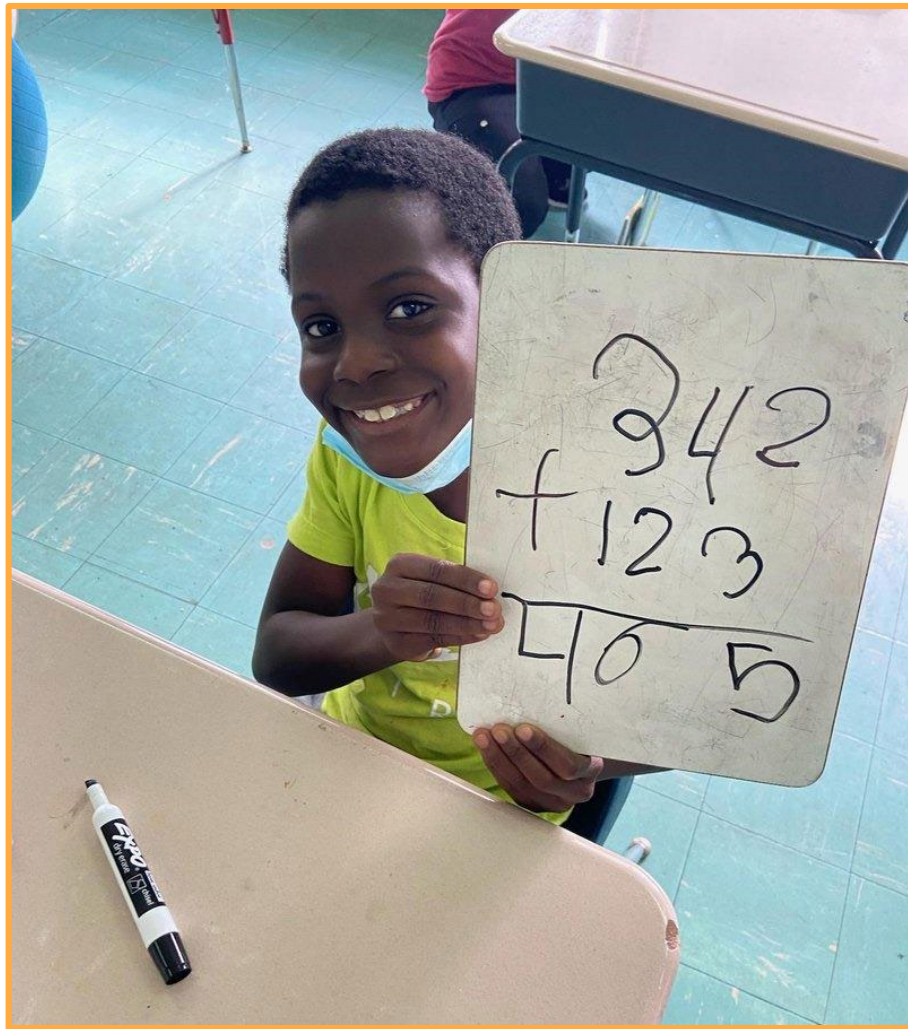

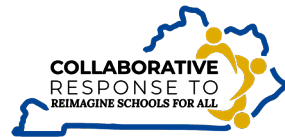

Deeper Learning competencies promote the ability to transfer learning and *apply it to new and complex situations in an ever-changing global environment.*







The team will work together to create a plan for engaging further into deeper learning for all kids.

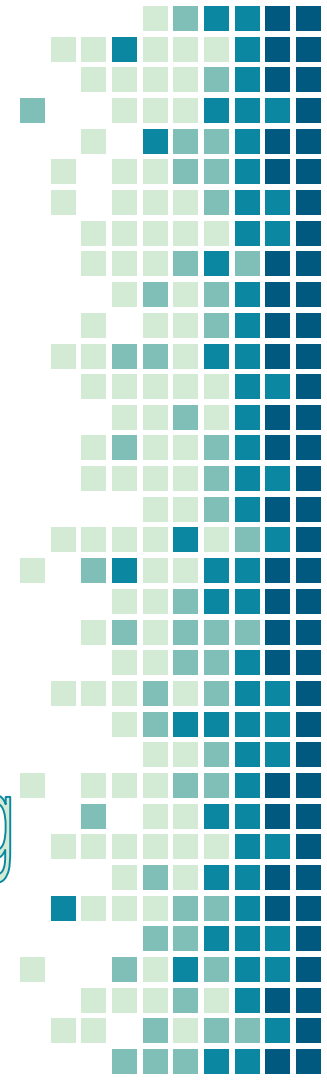
