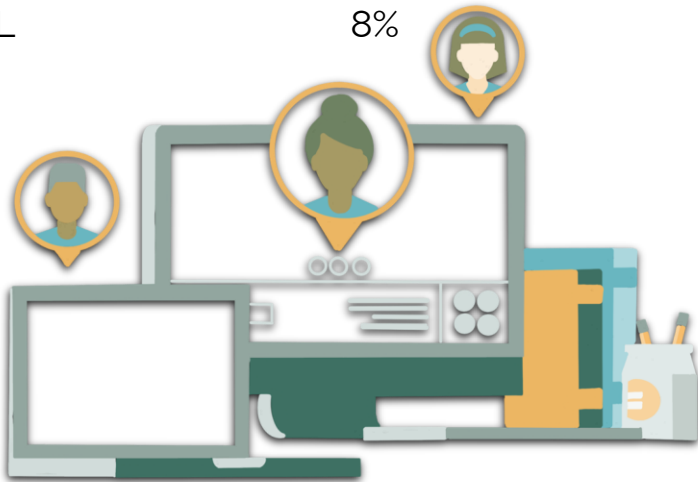
Approved July 27, 2021

Expanded to serve K-5

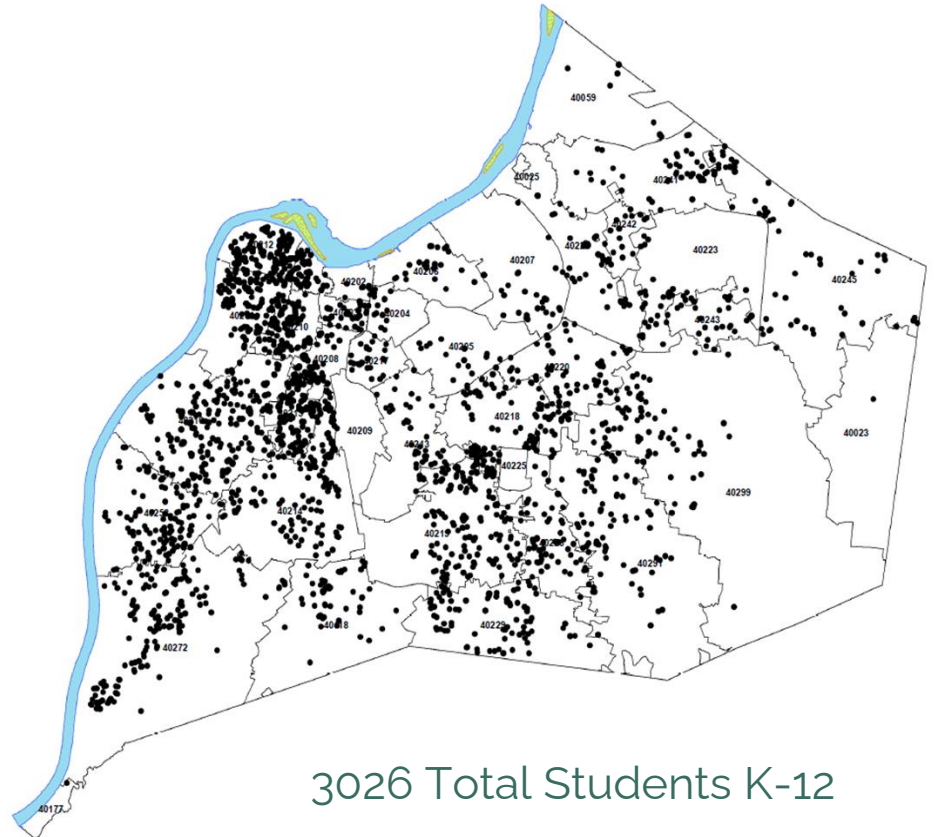


Student Demographics

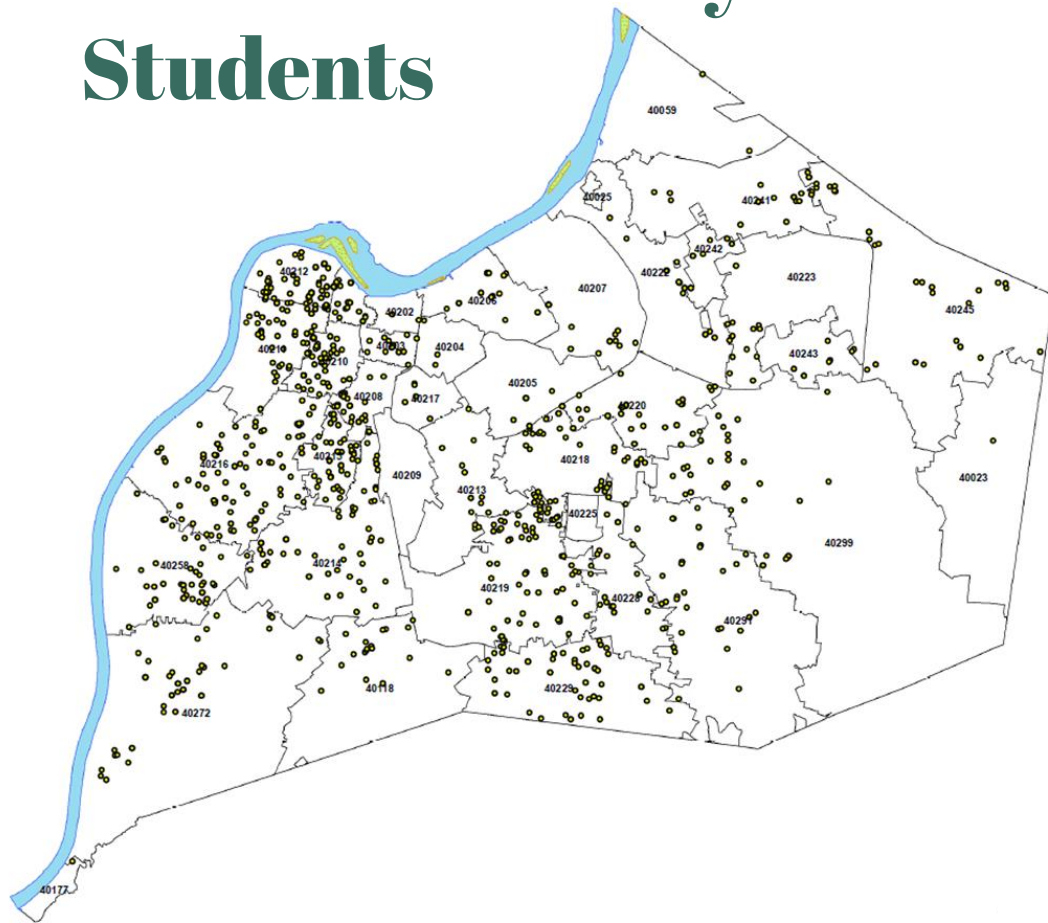

ELEMENTARY PROPOSAL FOR 2022-23

Recommend providing a K-5 Option

Pathfinder students from 21-22 must meet to re-enroll

- 80% attendance
- 80% coursework completed
- Participated in state testing (incoming 4th/5th only)
- Appeal process will be available

Open seats will be filled with new students

80% attendance for SY 2021-22 for incoming 1st through 5th

Instructional Model

All classes taught by a JCPS teacher
Curriculum based on JCPS Frameworks
