**Transportation:**

- All transportation for Summer School routes have been completed.

**Facilities:**

- The mobile kitchens arrival was delayed for one week. However, the site is prepared once it arrives. May 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Mark Watts has been attending all of the meetings related to NPS kitchen and cafeteria.
- Flooring projects are beginning in the district at NHS and NIS.
- I have submitted to Mr. Watts my response for the stadium project. I have attached a copy for the Board as well. This response is my recommendation on what we need without addressing the track or field. It also does not include new bleachers in the high school gym which are needed as well.

**Safe Schools**

- The Safe Schools Report has been reviewed and once Ms. Swanson and Mr. Watts verify it will be complete.
- I have also requested through Ky Center for Safe Schools to have an audit conducted at NHS and NIS in the upcoming year.
- The new Safe Schools Coordinator will need to be assigned and have training in July.

Without the work of our facilities and transportation dept, school would not happen. They are a dedicated group that doesn't work for recognition.
