

## Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Eligibility and Reimbursement

### Identified Student Defined

A student in a school, a group of schools, or a district who is categorically eligible for free meals. The student must be identified by direct certification to be counted as an identified student. SNAP enrollment outweighs all other Assistance Programs for direct certification. No applications are used.

### How to Calculate the Identified Student Percentage (ISP)

(Based on April 1<sup>st</sup> Data)

$$\frac{\text{Identified Students}}{\text{Enrolled Students}} \times 100 = \text{Identified Student Percentage}$$

Example:

$$\frac{\text{Identified Students (248)}}{\text{Enrolled Students (420)}} \times 100 = \text{An ISP of 59.00\%}$$

### Minimum ISP to Qualify for CEP

A school or group of schools must have an ISP of at least **40%**. The ISP is then multiplied by 1.6 to find the school's free reimbursement rate. The number 1.6 represents the average number of students who would turn in an application to establish income eligibility for free meals if applications were being used.

### Federal Reimbursement Formula for CEP Schools

**Example  
1**

A school with an ISP of 40% would receive the free reimbursement rate for 64 % of the meals it served and the paid rate for 36% of the meals it served.



**Example  
2**

A school with an ISP of 62.5% or greater would receive the free reimbursement for 100% of the meals it served.

### Instructions

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) provides an alternative to household applications for free and reduced price meals for economically disadvantaged students in local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools. Sites that elect this option agree to serve all students free lunches and breakfasts for four (4) successive school years and claim the meals based on a percentage of Identified Students multiplied by a USDA-defined multiplier factor.

Sites which have an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) of 40% or greater are eligible for this option.  
Sites which have an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) between 30.00% - 39.99% are potentially eligible.
