- Update on our Scheduling for the 2022-2023 school year:
 - Students in grades 9-12 received schedules for the 2022-2023 school year on last day of school.
- Report Cards for the 4th Quarter/End of Year were shared on Friday, June 3rd
- College and Career Readiness – Class of 2022 finished at 70% of class being College and Career Ready (39/56) (70%)
- Graduation Rate for Class of 2022:
 - 98%
 - 55/56
 - One senior was a reclassification due to pandemic and will graduate with the class of 2023
- **Summer School:**
 - Dates: Monday, June 6th – Friday, June 24th
 - Monday – Friday
 - 8:30 – 11:30
 - Enrolled on Monday, June 6th: 84
 - Middle School: 22
 - High School: 62
 - Seniors: 0
 - Juniors: 13
 - Sophomores: 22
 - Freshmen: 27



As of Tuesday, June 22nd:

Middle School Update:

- 12 students completed all requirements to complete summer school.
- 4 students have completed part of their summer school courses.
- 20 middle school credits have been earned.

High School Update:

- 27 students completed all requirements to complete summer school.
- 9 additional students completed part of their summer school courses.
- 60 high school credits have been earned.

Attendance:

- Attendance percentage was 50%.
- Attendance dropped significantly after 1.5 weeks.
- There are 26 students who have missed all or most of summer school.
 - Steps taken to improve attendance during summer school are the following:
 - Use of all calls.
 - Infinite Campus messages.
 - Home visits have been completed on these students.
 - Attendance drastically increases if you take the chronically absent students out of the calculations.
- Summer Enrichment Program:
