Consent Agenda Item (Action Item):

Approve agreement with Nevco Sports LLC to purchase and install Video boards to be used with CarRider Pro.

Applicable State or Regulations:

BOE Policy 01.11, 04.7, 04.8

Budget/Financial Issues:

The project will use \$703,678.40 ARP ESSER Funds

Background:

With the installation of CarRider Pro at our eight Elementary and Middle School (Adams Middle, Prestonsburg Elementary, Allen Elementary, Betsy Layne Elementary, JM Stumbo Elementary, South Floyd Elementary, May Valley Elementary, and Duff-Allen Central Elementary) you must have a video display to display student's information as parents arrive to pick up their students using CarRider Pro. The Kentucky Department of Education has approved the use of ARP ESSER funds to install Video displays to us with CarRider Pro.

We have selected NEVCO Sports LLC, as the partner to install video displays. They have developed a partnership with CarRider Pro and built an interface so both systems will communicate. This will allow seamless operation between both systems and no integration set-up by Floyd Co. personal.

Sale of Goods Agreement

This agreement for the sale of goods is entered as of July 13th 2022, by and between Nevco Sports LLC, and Floyd County School District.

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. Sale of Goods: Pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, Nevco agrees to provide custom designed and manufactured sports scoreboards/video and deliver possession to the Customer, and the Customer shall pay for and accept from Nevco, the "Goods" listed at such prices as agreed by the Parties in this Agreement.
 - 1.1. Description of Goods Sold: The Customer is purchasing from Nevco custom designed and manufactured (16) 6.92'h x 10.24'w 6mm LED Video Display, (6) Nevco Model 2702 10'w x 3'h Scoreboards, Custom Filler Panels, Virtual Scoring, Virtual Integration with Car Rider Pro, all associated equipment, and all software/hardware necessary per Nevco quote 00139265. A copy of this quotation is attached to and consideredpart of this agreement. Freight is included. Taxes are not included, if applicable. Also attached with this contract are renderings and project responsibility documentthat are considered part of this contract. Installation is not part of this contract and will be contracted individually with installer with Nevco oversight.
- 2. Purchase Price: As consideration for the sale of the goods, the Customer shall pay to Nevco the purchase price of \$703,678.40 (the "Purchase Price"). This price does not include tax. Freight is part of the quote total. Installation is included in total pricing for each school location. Freight based on multiple trucks dropping at one central location.

- 4. Payment Term: Payment terms for the \$703,678.40 due to Nevco will be 50% down (\$351,839.20) due by 11/30/2022. Remaining balance \$351,839.20 due Net 30 after installation, commissioning, and training of all locations is complete.
- * If customer has delays after shipment due to construction, power, etc, Nevco can collect 40%*
- 5. **Delivery of Goods/Shipping:** Nevco shall deliver the goods per the terms listed below provided contract and all necessary approvals occur in a timely manner:
 - 5.1. Date of Shipment: Date of shipment is scheduled to be no later than 2/28/22
 - 5.2. Location of Delivery: Central District Warehouse 442 KY Rt 550 Eastern, KY 41622
 - 5.3. Risk of damages: Nevco assumes responsibility for the Goods, and all risk of damage, loss, or delay of the Goods, until the Goods are delivered to or collected by the Customer. Once the Goods have been delivered to or collected by the Customer, the Customer assumes all responsibility for and risk of damage to such Goods.
 - 6. Force Majeure: Nevco and the Customer shall not be considered in default hereunder or be liable for any failure to perform or delay in performing any provisions of this Agreement in the customary manner to the extent that such failure

or delay is caused by any reason beyond its control, including any act of God. The Party whose performance has been interrupted by such circumstances shall use every reasonable means to resume full performance of this Agreement as promptly as possible.

7. Representations:

7.1. Authority to Sign: Each party promises to the other party that it has the authority to enter into this agreement and to perform all its obligations under this agreement.

8. General:

- 8.1. Choice of Law and Venue: This agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Illinois with venue in Madison County, Illinois.
- **8.2** Full Agreement: This is the full agreement between the parties, any further modification, extension, or alteration must be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 8.3 Modification(s): A Modification is a written amendment to the Agreement for changes in the Work signed by both parties. Nevco shall review and prepared, timely requests by the Customer for changes in the Work, including adjustments to the Contract Sum or Contract Time. With the Customer's approval, Nevco shall incorporate those estimates into a Change Order or other appropriate documentation for the Customer's execution. Changes ordered by Customer shall be performed and paid for in accordance with the terms of this agreement (payment due 30 days net after completion of change order). Change orders will include the actual direct costs of said work plus up to fifteen percent (15%) for overhead, profit, and supervision.
- **8.4. Signatures:** Nevco and the Customer must sign this document either electronically or in hardcopy. If this document is signed in hard copy, it must be returned to Nevcofor valid record. Electronic signatures count as originals for all purposes
