Recommendation/Motion: Approve Student Meal Price Increase for SY 22-23

Background/Rationale: School Program regulations at 7 CFR 210.14(e) require school food authorities (SFAs) participating in the National School Lunch Program to ensure sufficient funds are provided to the nonprofit school food service account for meals served to students not eligible for free or reduced price meals. There are two ways to meet this requirement: either through the prices charged for “paid” meals or through other non-Federal sources (the District Funds) provided to the nonprofit school food service account. Student meal prices were last increased SY 2016-17.
