Caution: This message originated from outside the Floyd County School's Organization. Be aware of the sender and any suspicious links.

Good afternoon, Linda,

Here is what I have learned regarding the Betsy Layne ES roof bid.

- According to Dixie Roofing, Material costs were very high. As and example, low-rise adhesive foam has tripled in price from \$500/kit to \$1600/kit. Each kit covers 5 squares and the roof is 730 squares.
- · Wage rates in Floyd Co, particularly for sheet metal workers is about \$60/hr.
- The older portion of the building posed a lot of challenges since it has a tectum deck, asbestos, and needed additional roof drains.
- Brad Sharp of Dixie Roofing thought there may be some cost savings by reducing the slope from 1/4" per foot to 1/8" per foot, and eliminating all new roof drains.
- · The two other contractors that were at the pre-bid did not bid because
 - They couldn't get subcontractors to give them pricing for the abatement or Mechanical scope. If they
 had gotten subs, they wanted to bid. Or,
 - They were busy and this did not fit into their schedule at this time.
- I did some cost/SF analysis and compare what Betsy Layne came is at compared other recent bids in our
 office: TPO is typically the most cost effective with SBS being the most costly.

Betsy Layne ES	TPA (Single-ply Thermal Plastic Alloy)	\$54
Wingo ES (Graves Co.)	SBS (Two-ply SBS Modified Bitumen)	\$33
Rowan Co. Sr. HS	TPO (Single-ply Thermoplastic Polyolefin)	\$14

The Options for the Board are the following:

- Make a motion to reject the bid in its entirety. (Then we would rebid the roof in the future after doing a few value engineering items.)
- 2. Make a motion to award contract to Dixie Roofing's bid in the Amount of \$2,015,265, pending KDE approval.
