Performance Expectations

- Enrollment = Students attending for 12+ hours
 - Upon enrollment, students complete an initial assessment to determine educational level
 - FY 22-23 Enrollment Goal = 2,684
- Measurable Skill Gains (MSG) = After 40 hours of attendance students are required to take a post test to determine if they have improved an educational level. If have improved they are included in our MSG numbers
 - FY 22-23 MSG Goal = 45.2% of enrolled students (1,213 of enrolled students)
- GED = Number of students who have passed all 4 GED Ready Tests <u>and</u> all 4 GED Tests (Math, Reasoning Through Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies)
 - FY 22-23 GED Goal = 483
