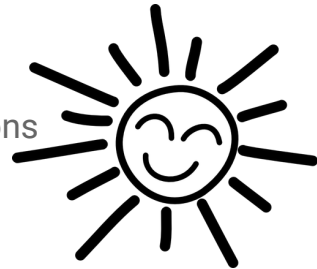


Early Childhood Opening Schedule:

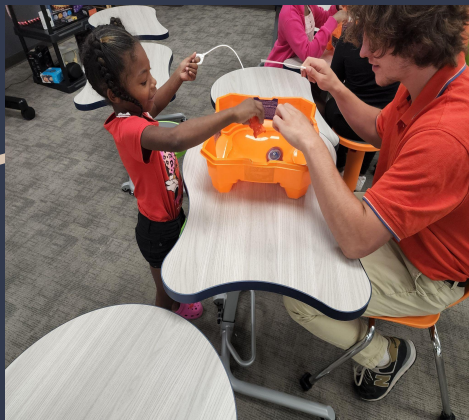
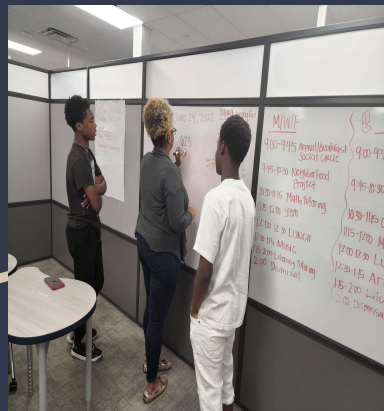


Elev8 Opening Schedule:
