TRANSIENT BOAT DOCK DESIGN

DESCRIPTION: Brandstetter Carroll is working to complete the design for a 500' transient

boat dock on the Ohio River just west of the Pier. This dock would accommodate boaters traveling up and down the Ohio with the ability for

overnight docking, fuel, electric, water, and sewage facilities.

START DATE: August 2021 EST. COMPLETION: July 2022 DESIGN COST: \$343,290

DEPT: Administration/Engineering

MONTHLY CHGS: The Commission approved moving forward with bidding the project on 8/2/22. The new dock will be 400' long, with the restrooms being removed from the project bringing the total cost in at \$9.5 million. The design team is completing the last portions of the drawing details and beginning to prepare bid documents. Coordination is ongoing with the permitting agencies over the river (Army Corp of Engineers, Division of Water, and Coast Guard) to ensure we are cleared to move forward with the bidding of the dock sections

before we actually receive our construction permit. We will be splitting this project into two phases so that the dock portions can be bid out and production started, while we bid the installation to a

general contractor.

YORK DITCH STORMWATER PROJECT

DESCRIPTION: Drainage improvements in the area bounded by Dallas Ave to the west,

Harlan Ave to the east, N. Stratford Dr to the north, and Bittel Rd to the

south.

START DATE: July 2022 EST. COMPLETION: May 2024 BUDGET: \$5M
