The Board paused to acknowledge the tragic death of Bill Brown, who was an assistant basketball coach at Bryan Station High School. Our hearts remain with his family, the Bryan Station High School community, and all those touched by his passing.

The board also acknowledged the passing of Dr. Ronald Walton, who served as superintendent of the Fayette County Public Schools from 1984 to 1994. Dr. Walton recognized the importance of arts and music education in providing a full experience for students, and was a very strong advocate for building arts programs in FCPS and the broader community. During his tenure he formed the Taskforce for Excellence, which brought educators and community members together to study model arts education programs. Their work led to the creation of the School for the Creative and Performing Arts in the fall of 1987 and the development of a strong infrastructure for district visual and performing arts offerings K through 12. Dr. Walton is remembered as a superintendent who was very supportive of principals and the district staff. He was a man of great integrity who served FCPS honorably during a time of growth and change.
