The softball team finished with a 33-3 record. They won the 6^{th} district tournament, 2^{nd} second region tournament and their opening game at the state tournament.

The boys golf team won the Union County Invitational, its first invitational in at least 5 years.

The girls golf team won the Union County Invitational. Meryl Grogan finished 2nd in that event. We are hosting the region tournament at the Henderson Country Club.

The football team opens up on August 19 against Calloway County in the Hall of Fame Game.

Girls soccer won their opening game against Hopkins County Central, 2-0.

The boys soccer team opens up on Thursday, August 11 at home against Hopkins County Central.

The first cross country meet is in Owensboro on August 16.

The first volleyball game is August 18 at Webster County.
