

# JCPS School Choice Plan



On June 1, 2022 a historical moment occurred when the JCPS Board approved the School Choice Plan to ensure an improved experience for all students and families leading with equity in mind, building stronger trust, and fostering a transparent, trustworthy system.

#### **JCPS Commitment:**

- Guarantee a Dual Resides option for students in the Choice Zone
- Align feeder patterns for elementary, middle, and high school students
- Dedicate resourcing, funding, and support for the Choice Zone through the Choice Zone Support Plan
- Provide a new technology system and dedicated School Choice Outreach
- Implement a comprehensive magnet strategy that aligns with MSA and provides equitable access that leads to positive student outcomes

#### Dual Resides/Feeder Patterns:

- Updating systems to incorporate **Dual Resides/Feeder Patterns** to prepare for online application period
- Developing the School Choice Outreach Plan

West Louisville Middle School

- Swing space location (incoming 6th grade students in 2023-24)
- Identification of building principal-September/October
- Secure permanent location (potential site at 18th Broadway)
- Marketing and communications for Showcase of Schools

#### Choice Zone Support Plan:

- Identify the Director of Choice Zone-September
- Gather baseline data in 2022-23 for monitoring and accountability

Reminder: Implementation of staffing incentives and staffing advantages will go into effect spring 2023.




# Magnetic Strategic Plan Moving the work forward



# Implementatio n Timeline

### The following will be implemented in the 2023-2024 school year

- The proposed dual resides and aligned feeder patterns
- Phase 1 of the magnet recommendations
  - Whole school magnets at Hawthorne, Coleridge-Taylor, Foster, Western MS, Academy@Shawnee MS, Western HS
- One new elementary schools (West Louisville Elementary School) and two middle schools will open (West Louisville Middle School swing space and Echo Trail Middle School)
- Dual resides starts with kindergarten, 6th and 9th graders, all other students can remain at their current school

Changes will be considered based on the findings from the annual summative evaluation process. A comprehensive review of the school choice plan will be implemented every 10 years, aligned with the new census data.
