History/Background:

Green Dot is a nationally recognized program focused on Power-Based Personal Violence (Bullying, hazing, Partner violence, sexual harassment, and Stalking). The Green Dot Strategy is based around the belief that each one of us holds power as bystanders to actively prevent violence and to help shape our community norms. The program will train students to be active bystanders and help change the culture of the school and the community.

Recommended Action:

The administration at Betsy Layne High School request this program be implemented during the 2022-2023 school year with the option of growing more leaders as the years progress. While our school culture is overall positive, any potential to grow more leaders would be greatly appreciated.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BY and BETWEEN

Betsy Layne High School

554 Bobcat Blvd, Stanville, KY 41659

And

Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program 104 S. Front St. Prestonsburg, KY 41653

A. This is a Memorandum of Agreement on the part of the Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program designated crisis center for the Big Sandy Region, and Betsy Layne High School. The Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program and the school shall jointly be referred hereinafter as the "parties."

PURPOSE:

- The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to guide and direct the parties regarding
 their working relationship and the joint provision of the Green Dot for High Schools, a
 primary prevention education program to reduce the incidence of power-based personal
 violence and thereby create gradual social and cultural change.
- 2. Nothing in this Memorandum alters in any way the respective legal rights of the parties or their legal obligations to one another, to their constituents or to any third party.

B. GENERAL UNDERSTANDING:

- The Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program is the regional crisis center
 designated to provide regional rape crisis services and are required, in part, pursuant to KRS 211.600
 and 920KAR 2:070 to provide services to any victim of sexual assault or abuse requesting such
 service. These services shall include, but not be limited to crisis counseling, mental health and related
 support services, advocacy, consultation, public education, and provision of training of professionals.
- Betsy Layne High School is the high school located at 554 Bobcat Blvd, Stanville, KY 41659 and
 has chosen to receive prevention education provided by Mountain Comprehensive Care
 Center/Healing Program beginning in the School Year Fall/Spring of 2022-2023.
- 3. The name of the specific prevention education curricula that will be used in the high school for the purposes of reducing power-based personal violence is the Green Dot for High Schools program, which is designed, authored, and adapted for high school use by Dr. Dorothy Edwards of Green Dot, ETC. The Green Dot for High Schools program has proven to be effective in reducing the perpetration of interpersonal forms of violence through a CDC funded research study name Green Dot across the Bluegrass conducted by the University of Kentucky.
- 4. For the purposes of implementing the provisions of this Memorandum of Agreement, there shall be no discrimination on the basis of race, national origin, religion, creed, sex, gender identity, special orientation, age, disability, or residence status in the provision of prevention education services to any student.
- 5. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be in effect from August 2022 through the end of the school year.

Mountain Comprehensive Care Center Shall:

- a. Implement the Green Dot program facilitated by a trained educator designated by the Center.
- b. Keep the school officials at Betsy Layne High School informed of scheduling, curricula, surveying, data, program outcomes and/other activities conducted at the school related to Green Dot for High Schools.

- Keep confidential the evaluation data specific to Betsy Layne High School gathered throughout the school year.
- d. Allow the school all discretion regarding who is told about the school's participation in the project and how such information is shared.

Betsy Layne High School Shall:

- a. Allow staff from Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program access to the students enrolled in the school for the provision of the Green Dot for High School's primary' prevention and evaluation of that program through the use of survey instruments for the entire school year.
- b. Name a single point of contact person from the school to receive ongoing communication regarding the activities to be conducted in this project.
- c. Inform Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program of any other prevention programming implemented at Betsy Layne High School throughout the project period.
- d. Participate in the program as it was designed so that the results, as proven through research, will be achieved.

MUTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Mountain Comprehensive Care Center / Healing Program

- a. The parties will work together to maintain a consistent and continuous level of equality, respect and non-violence in the school. At the request of either party, a meeting or conference will be held between Mountain Comprehensive Care Center/Healing Program and Betsy Layne High School.
- b. This relationship is intended solely for the mutual benefit of the parties and their clients hereto, and there is no intention, expressed or otherwise, to create any rights or interests for any party or person other than the parties without limiting the generality of the foregoing.
- c. Neither party is an agent, employer or servant of the other.
- d. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be governed by, construed and applies in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- e. The parties will a Business Agreement in accordance with federal HIPPA regulations.
