Background and Rationale: Floyd County Board of Education has been in a contractual agreement with renewable contractual agreement with Premier Integrity Solutions/Envivo Diagnostics operating as Cornerstone Diagnostics to provide and coordinate drug testing for the district employees and students on 06/12/2017. To continue services for the 2022-2023 school year a bid process implemented completed. Cornerstone met the requirements of the bid process and submitted a bid complete with drug testing outline and pricing. Cornerstone was the sole respondent in the advertised bid process. In this day and time, alcohol and other forms of drug abuse have grown to major proportions in our society. The middle and high school settings and employees are not exempt from this phenomenon. Therefore it is critical that we continually look for ways to institute programs that encourage a drug-free lifestyle. The drug testing program facilitates mandatory compliance with the District's established standards of conduct, including those that prohibit use of alcohol/drug abuse in our school system
