LE Gregg

LE Gregg presented a lump sum fee of \$42,020 to perform special inspection services for the base bid portion of this project and a lump sum fee of \$53,146 for all of the alternates to be included. A minimum of a 24-hour notice must be provided to LE Gregg when services are needed.

Solid Ground

Solid Ground was non-responsive.

S&ME

S&ME presented a lump sum fee of \$34,000 to perform special inspection services for the base bid portion of this project and a lump sum fee of \$40,000 for all of the alternates to be included. A minimum of a 48-hour notice must be provided to S&ME when services are needed.

Conclusion

Based on the cost, personnel proposed, and the scope of work to be performed, we are recommending that S&ME be awarded the Special Inspections and Construction Materials Testing work.
