All indications through both building-level feedback and observation, we have gotten off to a very good start. Processes, procedures and routines seem to be ahead of traditional timeframes.

In the assessment realm, we are in the early stages of data clean-up as far as rosters of tested students and accountable students. Quality control days have not been definitively set, but are anticipated to be around the second week of September. If that is the guidance for QC days, final scores should be available in late September.

We have joined the WKEC and other regional districts in the Deeper Learning initiative. This is a district-wide effort to advance classroom instruction and learning to best prepare our students for the future. We are in the early implementation stage of establishing the administrative team and the teacher cohort.

We should have good initial diagnostic data for the September board meeting from both the elementary and the jr/sr high school. IReady as well as CERT results should be available.
