Ryle High School Marching Band Hawaii Trip Information December 3rd-December 9th, 2022

To whom it may concern,

In the spring of 2021, the band director team at Ryle began discussing how we could rebound from the impact of the pandemic and virtual learning on our band program. We all agreed that an exciting trip would be a great way to generate interest in potential new members to our program, as well as excite our current members about the future ahead of them! We applied for several educational performance opportunities, and we were incredibly fortunate to be selected to perform as a part of the 2022 Pearl Harbor Memorial Services and Parade in December of 2022!!! This will be a once in a lifetime opportunity for our students and our program, and we are very proud to represent Ryle High School, Boone County Schools, the city of Union, and our great commonwealth as we take part in this memorial of such a significant moment in our nation's history!

Some educational/performance highlights of the trip include:

- A visit to Pearl Harbor and the USS Arizona Memorial
- A visit to the Polynesian Cultural Center

Out of our 152 Marching Band Members, 128 of our students will be attending this trip. The trip cost per student is \$2,400, which covers their airfare, hotel accommodations, and charter bus transportation while on island. The Ryle Band boosters will also contribute approximately \$75,000 to help cover ancillary trip costs (instrument luggage costs, additional meals, chaperone expenses, etc.) We've worked very hard to give families as all-inclusive of a trip as possible as well as allow a longer time period to submit payments.

In addition to the two Ryle Band Directors and the two Gray MS Band Directors, we will be traveling with Mr. Shafer our Principal, eight of our Marching Band Staff members, and twelve of our school approved band parent chaperones (25 adults in total).
