Emergency Certified Substitute Information

Rank IV- BA degree or 96 hours of college credit

Rank V- 64 to 95 college credit hours

We are required annually to approve these in order to complete
Emergency Certified Substitute applications through EPSB.


Emergency Non-Certified School Personnel Program

This is above and beyond the previous recommendation for Emergency Substitutes who would be considered Rank IV or V.

The Emergency Non-Certified School Personnel Program allows participating school districts to use persons with a high school diploma, or its equivalent, when all other qualified substitutes are unavailable.

Records of these subs are kept at the district level and reported to EPSB quarterly.

Include an additional Rank on the substitute salary tables for these substitutes- Rank VI.
