Bonding Potential- History

- Ross Sinclair is our Fiscal Agent to assist with the sale of bonds. Bonds are similar to taking out a mortgage on a home.
- Currently owe in previous bond sales
- In October of 2021 Bonding Potential on a 20 year bond was estimated at \$20,290,000- Only had \$50,852.00 left to use on other projects
- In <u>December of 2021 Bonding Potential</u> was looked at for a 25 year period- had \$22,915,000 bonding potential with \$62,059 left to use on other projects

Good Possibilities For Project

- Increase in bonding potential is good- more for other future projects
- Legislature requested information from districts on projects
 that couldn't be funded due to costs and lack of funding.
 We submitted two forms- <u>SES New Construction</u> and <u>SES</u>
 <u>Roof Project</u> to see if we could receive additional funding
 from legislature
- We are working with Stanton Elementary staff to review the project and determine if changes need to be made- Expand the gym, cafeteria, kitchen for dry storage- in exchange for some of the other features that aren't necessities.



Good Possibilities For Project

- <u>House Bill 678</u>- Allows us to possibly push through an expansion to the gym and cafeteria/kitchen- This was not passed until May of 2022
- Because our community supported our district with the nickel tax, we have the potential to receive other funding from the legislature as well.
- Even if no other funding comes in, we will be able to build the building we want and are working towards getting the project on its way.
