

Currently Working On:

- TVA STEM Classroom Grant Program. The grant is designed to fund STEM learning projects in classrooms and schools in the TVA service area. This is being written to fund the Stem Lab at ACIC.
- Kentucky Dept. of Education, Mathematics Achievement Fund Mini Grant; requesting \$40,000/school (all five schools). For the purchase of materials needed for modification of instruction (tier one, tier two, and tier three) in mathematics and pay for extended time or release time for teachers to engage in professional learning of the new mathematics materials purchased. The grant is for one year (spring 2023-6/30/2024).
- US Dept. of Education, Project Prevent Grant Program; requesting \$4,000,000. No match required. The program is designed to expand the capacity of LEAs to implement community- and school-based strategies to help prevent community violence and mitigate the impacts of exposure to community violence.

Submitted Grants:

- US Dept. of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, STOP School Violence Program Grant; requested \$1,000,000. No match required. The program is designed to improve K-12 school security by providing students and teachers with tools needed to recognize, respond quickly to, and help prevent acts of violence and ensure a positive school climate.
- US Dept. of Education, Education Innovation and Research Program – Early-Phase Grant; requested \$4,000,000. 10% match required. Five year grant. Funds will be used for teacher professional development opportunities in STEM and deeper learning components, developing a STEM Lab and Innovation Academy at the Learning Center and micro labs at each school. EIR is a research-based grant and includes a significant evaluation process of the work undertaken by the grant.
- Community-Led Education Initiatives Fund; Requesting \$400,000. No match required. The fund supports “community-driven initiatives to catalyze extraordinary, equitable learning experiences in mid-sized and smaller cities, or rural areas across the US. Grants will provide support to existing or emergent community-driven initiatives to help accelerate change.”
