This change order proposed pricing was initiated by the Contractor reportedly in response to a Field Order issued to clarify the rim and invert elevations for a few drainage structures intended to be at no additional cost. This proposal has been reviewed with revision comments by RTA, and the Contractor has indicated this value requested remains reasonable. The additional cost requested reports 70% for Equipment & Labor. The proposed change also included a request for eight (8) additional days to address the work.


