Northern Kentucky Bowling Association High School Varsity Bowling Center Agreement

Northern Kentucky High School Varsity Bowling 2022/2023

It is m	utually agreed by and between

1.	A minimum of lanes will be leased and hired by the above-named high school consisting
	of teams for a period of no less than one 2-hour practice per week beginning October 1,
	2022, ending on February 7, 2023. The number of lanes leased can vary from school-to-school
	based on bowling team squad size.

- 2. A *minimum* of 9 competitive matches will be held with NKAC schools and the matches shall bowl based on negotiation with the host facility for day of the week and time for the match start, beginning on November 1, 2022 and ending January 19, 2023. The number of competition dates/times may vary by school. Competition start times will be negotiated with the facility based on lane availability. Practice will start 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. The telescores will automatically be started at the scheduled practice time.
- 3. The high school through its school administration shall pay the center for rental of the lanes at the rate agreed to per team per season (\$600 per team). If a high school fields both a boys and girls team the total cost would be a two-team rate per season. League fees shall be paid to the host facility no later than November 30, 2022. Any extension needed for payment of these fees must be negotiated with the host facility but are payable no later than December 31, 2022.
- 4. All schools will be required to pay a \$50 tournament entry fee to the host school for each team entered in the Regional Tournament. This fee is paid directly to Campbell County High School (Region 5) or Ryle High School (Region 6).
- 5. For schools entering teams/players in the adapted or unified divisions there is an additional fee of \$5 per unified team or \$2.50 per person for adapted bowlers that will be required for practice sessions and the regional tournament fee. The practice fees are paid via invoice to the host center and the regional tournament fee is paid to the host school (Campbell County or Ryle High School).
- 6. It is understood and agreed by the parties that postponements due to severe weather, holidays, and acts beyond the control of the center or the high school which prevent the use of the lanes by the league, shall release the center and/or high school from any responsibility for damage or claims of any nature whatsoever. It is also understood any postponements or delays for above-mentioned reasons, at the request of the high school, shall result in the high school making up all competitive sessions missed at a later date.
- 7. A minimum of two lanes will be kept open between high school bowling and open play, when possible. One pair of lanes will be set aside for practice use during the regulation games on the day of competitive matches when possible.
- 8. Additional services available upon request and at a mutually negotiated rate are:
 - Hosting of invitational tournaments by host facility schools. Fees associated with these invitational tournaments will be set with the mutual agreement of the host school and the host center.
 - Additional weekly practice4s. Fees associated with these additional practices will be negotiated with the host center.
- 9. Regional tournament events are the responsibility of the assigned school and all costs associated with this event will be negotiated with the host facility. The regional host schools for the 2022/2023 season are: Region 5 Campbell County High School; Region 6 Larry A. Ryle High School. The host school will meet with their selection for a host facility a minimum of 60 days prior to the event to work out details. Host school will pay the host facility \$50 per team

(boys & girls) for lineage for hosting the singles and team event. The adapted and unified events will be pay an additional fee of \$5 per team for a maximum cost of \$125 per school.
