- Progress Report Period for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Ended on Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>
  - Progress Reports Sent home on Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>
  - Included STAR Data Reports in Reading/Math
- FLEX Groups are set and interventions began on Monday, September 19<sup>th</sup>
  - FLEX Groups were established by looking at data from STAR Test, ASK Exam, and KYOTE
- Homecoming game took place on Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>
  - Parade to stadium
  - Dance on Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup>
- Held our September Grad Rate Tracking Meeting.
- I wanted to provide an update on our current post-secondary readiness numbers.
  - After the final KYOTE tests for this session, we are now at 37/61 students post-secondary ready for 60.7%.
  - Last year at same time of year our Post-Secondary numbers for comparison: 16/54 (29.6%) of students were fully college and/or career ready.
- High Number for this time of year and we are optimistic about having a great final year percentage of students postsecondary ready.
- Gutsy Goal for 2022-2023 school year is 85%; if the denominator stays at 61, this would take 52 kids earning academic or career readiness.
- Dr. Wright, Ms. Fields, and myself met and have a plan for every student (with the exception of one student who is in the Regional Schools Program) to attempt to get all students to post-secondary readiness status.



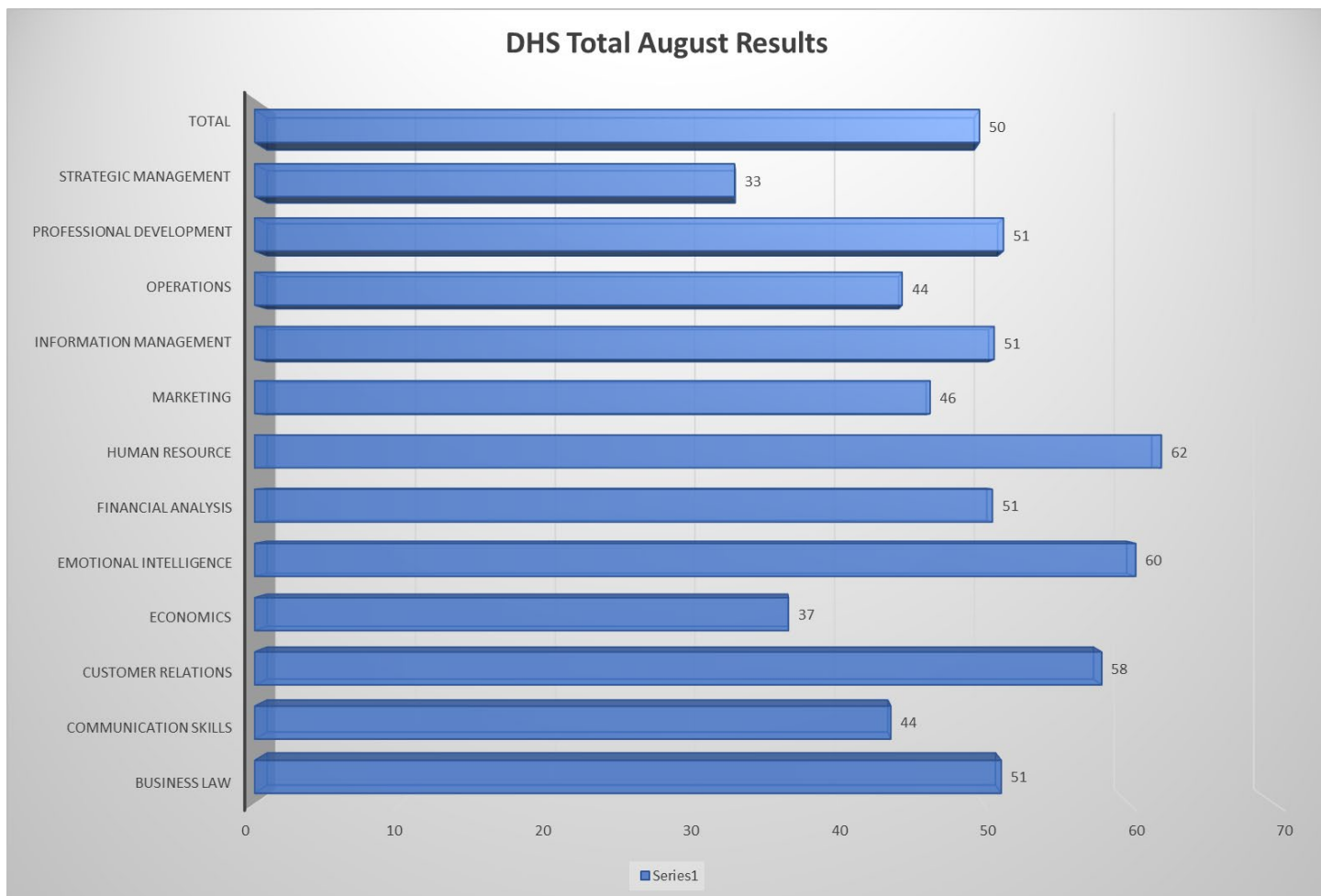
- We will continue to meet as an administrative team regularly to check on progress of students and look for additional ways to support students as they work toward postsecondary readiness.
- Additional Notes for Post-Secondary readiness:
  - Two students are with alternative assessment; alternative assessment students have a different pathway to postsecondary readiness and our students are generally both academic and career ready by the end of the school year..
  - Two students currently have a clear path to academic readiness through Gateway.
  - Four students currently have a clear path to career readiness through the ATC.
  - If only those eight students were to get postsecondary ready, that would put us at 73.7% post-secondary readiness.
  - Last year's final post-secondary rate was 70%.
  - Dayton High School's goal is for us to be at 85% post-secondary readiness.

### **Dual Credit Courses Update**

- 141 total courses being taken.
- 75 total courses taken by 15 students at YSA (Northern Kentucky University).
- 6 courses taken by 3 students at Gateway's Logistics Program.
- 60 credits taken by 30 students at Gateway's general studies program.

### **ASK Exam**

- The ASK Exam is the Assessment of Knowledge and Skills in Business. It is a 100-question, timed exam. The ASK Exam was given to 81 students this quarter. This group was comprised of seniors and anyone that is taking the Microsoft Specialist Classes. We did this because the ASK Exam is required for a student to be considered "Career Ready", along with three (3) MOS Certifications and three (3) Business Courses.
- We first gave the ASK Exam three years ago and a total of nine (9) students passed it. Last year we had 21 students that passed the exam and this year we had 5 students pass.
- As you can see in the chart below, the two biggest areas of struggle are Strategic Management and Economics. Both of these will be focuses of our Flex Bells:
