#### **HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

This is the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) change order for the Ryland Heights Addition and Renovation Project associated with Century Construction. The original contract was \$4,368,195.00. This change order for an additional \$9,625.86 with previous change orders totaling \$52,458.71 makes the new contract sum \$4,430,279.57.

- Item No 1: Add downspouts at Cafeteria roof in lieu of originally designed internal roof drains. ADD: \$ 2,675.03
- Item No 2: Add additional course of masonry to classroom wing exterior walls due to discrepancy between actual top of existing wall and the height indicated on original construction drawings for the previous classroom wing addition.

  ADD: \$4,529.44
- Item No 3: Add drain pipe to sprinkler room at Owner's request.

ADD: \$ 532.88

- Item No 4: Remove newly installed quarry tile in front of existing walk-in cooler due to cooler door rubbing on tile. ADD: \$ 375.14
- Item No 5: Add masonry bond beam at corridor 144 to support new wall above.

ADD: \$ 1,513.37

Cost Benefit to Owner: Downspouts were provided due to new/existing roof beams creating a conflict with installing new internal roof drains that would have been exposed below the ceiling.

Add additional course of masonry to classroom wing exterior walls due to discrepancy between actual top of existing wall and the height indicated on original construction drawings for the previous classroom wing addition

Cost Benefit to Owner: Additional masonry course required to bring wall height to design elevation

Add drain pipe to sprinkler room at Owner's request

Cost Benefit to Owner: Requested to provide a means to drain water from the room in the event the sprinkler riser leaks

ADD: \$532.88

Item No. 05-04 (PCA 45)

Remove newly installed quarry tile in front of existing walk-in cooler due to cooler door rubbing on tile

Cost Benefit to Owner: Tile required to be removed due to cooler door not able to open fully likely due to existing slab not

being level

ADD: \$375.14

Item No. 05-05 (PCO 46)

Add masonry bond beam (not indicated on structural drawings) at corridor 144 to support new wall above

Cost Benefit to Owner: Bond beam required to support new wall above spanning across corridor

ADD: \$1,513.37
