Consider/Approve applying for emergency certification for an elementary special education teacher at White's Tower Elementary for the remainder for the 22-23 school year.

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Kenton County School District posted a position on September 8, 2022 for a certified elementary special education teacher at White's Tower Elementary. The vacancy was posted on the District's website, the KDE website "Kentucky Educator Placement Service" and was publicized through social media on multiple occasions. There are currently no available applicants that hold a special education certification. An applicant has been recommended for the special education teaching position on an emergency certification basis who has a bachelor's degree and meets the GPA required by EPSB for this type of certification.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

\$0-there is no additional cost to the district for emergency certification of a teacher and the teacher will be paid from the Board approved salary schedule based on the EPSB assigned rank.
