Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve the contract with ACT for sophomore testing in the Spring of 2023.

Background/Rationale: The ACT provides an opportunity for students to show what they know. It is a highly respected, valid, reliable assessment that objectively measures what a students knowledge and aptitude are in the areas of Math, Reading, English, and Science. The ACT can open doors to admission at the nation's institutes for higher education and increase a students chance to earn a scholarship. The ACT identifies a students areas of strength and potential growth. Finally, the ACT serves as a key tool for students as they build a career and further their education plan.
