Currently Working On:

• <u>United Way of Southern Kentucky</u>; requesting \$15,000 for a week-long summer camp (Jump Start Kindergarten) for pre-kindergarten children to help prepare them to be kindergarten ready upon enrollment. This will be for a 2024 summer camp.

Submitted Grants:

- <u>US Dept. of Education, Project Prevent Grant Program;</u> requested <u>\$4,000,000</u>. No match required. The program is designed to expand the capacity of LEAs to implement community- and school-based strategies to help prevent community violence and mitigate the impacts of exposure to community violence. Five year grant. Funds will be used for a mental health professional in each school, relax and recharge spaces/rooms in each school, professional learning in Youth Mental Health First Aid and Trauma-Informed Care, etc.
- <u>US Dept. of Education, Education Innovation and Research Program Early-Phase Grant</u>; requested \$4,000.000. 10% match required. Five year grant. Funds will be used for teacher professional development opportunities in STEM and deeper learning components, developing a STEM Lab and Innovation Academy at the Learning Center and micro labs at each school. EIR is a research-based grant and includes a significant evaluation process of the work undertaken by the grant.
