704 KAR 7:125, KRS 159.030

Fiscal/Budgetary Impact:

The End of Year (EOY) average daily attendance (ADA) will determine the district budget for 2022-2023. House Bill 1 passed by the Kentucky Legislature in August (2022 special session) has a provision for flood-impacted school districts that states if ADA for SY 2022-2023 decreases by 3% or more than ADA from SY 2018-2019, the ADA for calculation of SEEK paid during SY 2023-2024 shall be increased by 2/3 of the decrease.

History/Background:

This is the first month since March 2020 where we are seeing authentic attendance data. After March 2020, we had a period of Participation Data followed by a year where students in Quarantined situations counted as present by utilizing a QRS code for attendance. This year neither of those are in place so we are seeing the 'real' attendance data. It's not pretty....yet. During this first month of school, we have seen Covid-19, Flu, Rhinovirus, RSV, Strep, Pink Eye, Stomach Virus, Lice, and a myriad of other health issues as we get re-acclimated to being back in school. Schools have made calls home daily, developed a school level Attendance Plan, met in Attendance PLCs weekly, and Truancy Court is operational. This year are focusing on Rebuilding Attendance Habits.
