 Rooms in the 3rd hallway are nearing completion.








 Front office area continues to take shape with offices/rooms starting to form.

The Deeper Learning district leadership met to learn more about the deeper learning competencies, project-based learning, and other instructional avenues to help students transfer learning.










 Teachers across the district collaborated during a Staff Development day on October 10.
