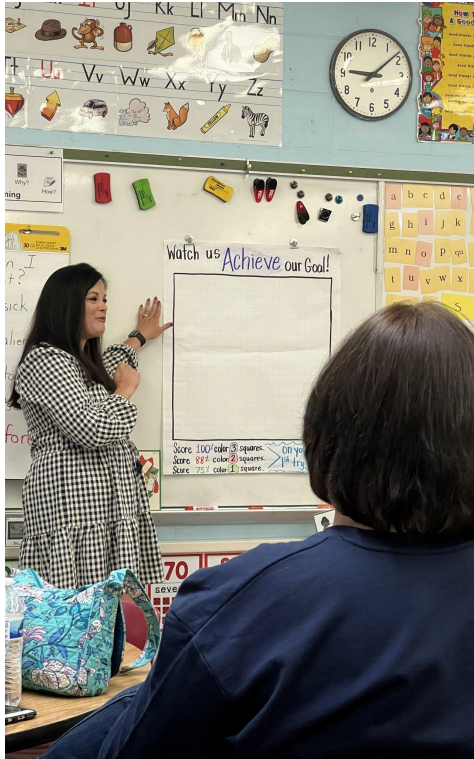
Professional Development
