- Second Quarter Progress Report Period ended on Monday, November 14th.
 - Progress Reports were sent home out of 7th bell classes on Wednesday, November 16th.
- ASVAB
 - o 37 students completed the exam
 - Test took place on Tuesday, November 1st
- Morehead State University visited with seniors on Thursday, November 10th
- We currently have 13 students that have passed the IC3 Level 1 Digital Literacy Exam. This exam is the first of three that each student (mostly Freshmen) must take to receive college credit for "Intro to Computers". We currently have 36 students registered in Digital Literacy.
- We currently have 16 students that have passed the Microsoft Word 2019 Certification. This is the first of three exams that will allow the students to be "Microsoft Office Specialist". Once a student completes these three exams they will have a college credit waiting for them.
