2022-23 Comprehensive Improvement Planning Timeline for Districts and Schools

The district and schools have been working to develop comprehensive improvement plans.

Through this intentional process, the district and schools identify priority needs, strategically allocate resources, and develop a process to monitor effectiveness. Plans will be shared in December for board approval.

2022-23 New Teacher Induction Program

New *Wildcat Educators* meet monthly to participate in professional learning opportunities focused on researched based high yield instructional strategies which will enhance and support their instructional practices and impact student achievement. Sessions focus on the following strategies: (Classroom Management, Teacher Clarity, Classroom Discussion, Effective Feedback, Metacognitive Strategies, and High Order Questioning)

Federal Funding Update

Consolidated Application - Title I and TItle III

Consolidated Application for federal funding have been approved. Private Schools monitoring has begun with visits to all private schools in November. Schools will be meeting with Title I coordinator in the coming weeks to finalize spending for the 22-23 SY.

ESSER Funding

New funding guidelines have been introduced to all districts through KDE Finance Office. KDE Federal Funds office will begin monitoring funds with the new guidance in several months. Federal Program Coordinators and Finance Officers are expected to update ESSER funding with new guidelines and be prepared for monitoring. This will be a priority as we enter 2023.
