

# AGREEMENT

between the

**LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY  
METROPOLITAN SEWER DISTRICT;**

and

**JEFFERSON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

pertaining to:

Construction of the JCPS Blue Lick Road Bus Compound Lateral Extension Project

This Agreement is made and entered into on this the 30<sup>TH</sup> day of November 2022, (the “Effective Date”) by and between the Louisville and Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District (“MSD”), 700 West Liberty Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40203, and Jefferson County Public Schools (“JCPS”) 3332 Newburg Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40218, (“MSD” and “JCPS” hereinafter are referred to as the “Parties”).

WHEREAS, MSD is a public body corporate and municipal corporation, duly created and existing pursuant to the provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 76, et. seq., acting by and through its duly appointed Board, its statutory governing body (hereinafter referred to as “MSD”).

WHEREAS, in the interest of the public health and for the purpose of providing adequate sewer and drainage facilities for the City of Louisville and the County of Jefferson, MSD was created pursuant to KRS Chapter 76; and

WHEREAS, MSD is empowered by KRS Chapter 76 to construct, acquire, operate and

maintain sewers, drains, sewer and drainage services and appurtenances in Jefferson County; and

WHEREAS, the existing JCPS Bus Compound property located at 10705 Blue Lick Road is currently served by an on-site wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, construction of a lateral extension is required to provide sanitary sewer service to the JCPS Bus Compound property located at 10705 Blue Lick Road; and

WHEREAS, JCPS agrees to fully reimburse MSD for construction costs for construction of the JCPS Blue Lick Road Bus Compound Lateral Extension Project (MSD Record Number 16863, and as shown in Attachment "A," which is incorporated as if set forth in full herein); and

WHEREAS, MSD will publicly bid the project for construction in accordance with MSD's procurement policy, procedure, and regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, for consideration, MSD and JCPS agree as follows:

**1. SERVICES:**

- a. MSD will advertise and bid construction of the JCPS Blue Lick Road Bus Compound Lateral Extension project in accordance with MSD's procurement policy, procedure, and regulations;
- b. MSD will compensate the successful bidder of construction of the JCPS Blue Lick Road Bus Compound Lateral Extension project in accordance with the bid documents;
- c. Upon completion of the JCPS Blue Lick Road Bus Compound Lateral Extension Project and MSD's acceptance of the work performed, JCPS shall fully reimburse MSD for all costs associated with the same within thirty (30) days of demand for payment from MSD.

**2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:** This Agreement shall begin upon execution, and shall continue until JCPS fully reimburses MSD. This Agreement shall not be modified except by the written agreement of all parties. No work may begin under this Agreement until all

parties have signed it.

**3. CAUSES AND TERMINATION:** MSD and/or JCPS may terminate this contract without cause after thirty days written notice or for cause immediately at any time.

Termination "for cause" is limited to a Party's material breach of this Agreement. In the event of termination, payment for services complete up to and including the date of termination shall be based upon work completed at that time.

**4. CONFLICT OF INTEREST:** The parties certify, by the signatures of duly authorized representatives on this Agreement, that they are legally entitled to enter into this Agreement and that they shall not be violating, either directly or indirectly, any conflict of interest statute of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by the performance of this Agreement.

**5. ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** This Agreement is the entire agreement and understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter set forth herein and this Agreement supersedes any and all prior and contemporaneous oral or written agreements or understandings between the parties relative thereto. No representation, promise, inducement, or statement of intention has been made by the parties that is not embodied in this Agreement.

**6. SUCCESSORS:** This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, successors and assigns.

**7. SEVERABILITY:** If any court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this Agreement unenforceable, such provision shall be modified to the extent required to make it enforceable, consistent with the spirit and intent of this Agreement. If such a provision cannot be so modified, the provision shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Agreement and shall not affect any other provision hereunder.

**8. COUNTERPARTS:** This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, in which case

each executed counterpart shall be deemed an original and all executed counterparts shall constitute one and the same instrument.






