Through this intentional process, schools and districts identify priority needs, strategically allocate resources, and monitor results to meet the needs of all students and close achievement gaps among identified subgroups.

The process and timeline for comprehensive school and district improvement planning are outlined in 703 KAR 5.225 Modifications have been made to the phases noted below to improve alignment and create efficient processes.
