Recommendation/Motion: A motion is in order to approve the Comprehensive District Improvement Plan.

Background/Rationale: The comprehensive district improvement plan (CDIP) is a collaborative process involving multiple stakeholders that promotes an environment of student growth and achievement. Through this intentional process, the district analyzed academic and nonacademic data and identified priority needs for all students while closing achievement gaps among identified subgroups.

Data Considerations: Through the development of the comprehensive district improvement plan, seven goals were identified based on state and district data. The goals were State Assessment Results in Reading and Math; State Assessment Results in Science, Social Studies, and Combined Writing; Achievement Gap, English Learner Progress; Quality of School Climate and Survey; Post-secondary Readiness; and Graduation Rate. Objectives over the next three years were developed along with four focus areas; Professional Learning Communities (PLCs), Assessment, Accelerated Learning, and Climate & Culture. These focus areas contain strategic activities, measures of success, and funding.
